Understand the requirements for supervising the removal of non-friable (Class B) Asbestos.

This course is aimed at Class B Asbestos removalists and supervisors who need to attend training to transition to meet the new licensing and training requirements to retain competency. It is essential that those involved with licensed asbestos removal work are compliant and knowledgeable of current legislation and the Approved Code of Practice to remove asbestos safely to reduce the risks of exposure and release of asbestos fibres.

- Understand safety procedures and processes required to ensure a safe system of work to carry out non-friable asbestos removal

- Develop leadership skills to support team members and oversee removal process, waste containment and decontamination
- Supervise testing and safety of work site to ensure compliance with legislation
