Hazardous Substances Update

What's changed?

Recent legislation changes affect the hazardous substances classifications included in our course: Management and Handling of Hazardous Substances. The seventh revised edition of the Globally Harmonised System (GHS 7) has been adopted as New Zealand's official hazard classification system. It takes effect from 30 April 2021.

What it means for our customers
