



Overview

VOC field assessments are designed to confirm the ongoing competency of trained individuals in their workplace environment. Completing a Dogman VOC ensures that safe and correct load-slinging and crane-directing procedures are being applied consistently on site.

This assessment is ideal for workers who already hold formal Dogman training or relevant unit standards and need to verify their current ability to perform Dogman duties safely and effectively.

Competency Assessed

The Verification of Competency for Dogman evaluates an operator's ability to apply sound judgement and practical skill when slinging loads and directing crane operations. Candidates will be required to demonstrate:

- > Effective communication with crane operators and ground personnel
- > Correct selection and inspection of lifting gear
- > Safe slinging of regular loads in accordance with industry regulations and workplace procedures
- > Application of hazard identification, risk management, and control measures
- > Understanding of responsibilities under the Approved Code of Practice for Cranes and relevant standards

Outcome

Upon completion, a Verification of Competency report will be provided detailing the individual's level of competency and outlining any areas that may require refresher training or additional supervision before future reassessment.
