
Crawler Crane







Overview

On course completion trainees will be able to apply theory and skills in lifting and placing loads with an overhead crawler crane and analyse and evaluate processes, through practical experience. This course is based on coaching and assessment only and is designed for trainees with experience in crawler crane operation.

Prerequisites

Attendees must hold the following NZQA Unit Standard:

Unit Standard: 3789 - Sling varied regular loads and safely direct a crane during crane operations.

Verified experiences from authorised verifier documented and observed lifts, or company documents with a minimum of 40 lifts (slinging and directing placement of load) with at least six variations of lifting operations that may include site, crane, loads, and communication methods.
