



Overview

This course is designed for workers who use hazardous substances as part of their day-to-day tasks, such as cleaning, maintenance, and operational roles. It provides learners with the practical skills and underpinning knowledge required to safely handle, store, use, and dispose of hazardous substances in accordance with workplace procedures and New Zealand health and safety legislation.

Course Content

- ✓ Define hazardous substances and explain their potential adverse effects on people and the environment.
- ✓ Identify hazardous substances commonly used in their workplace and interpret GHS labels and pictograms.
- ✓ Locate and use information from Safety Data Sheets to support safe handling, storage, and disposal.
- ✓ Apply workplace controls to minimise risks associated with hazardous substances.
- ✓ Select and correctly use appropriate PPE when working with hazardous substances.
- ✓ Safely handle, store, and dispose of hazardous substances in accordance with organisational procedures.
- ✓ Respond appropriately to spills or uncontrolled releases of hazardous substances, including emergency actions and reporting requirements.
